This program exists to connect older Russian orphans with forever families. Hosts of Hope provides an opportunity for groups of older children, approximately ages 6-12, with sibling groups possible, to visit the United States for a two week period. During this time the children stay in host homes. They will gain an international travel experience and have the opportunity to become linked with prospective adoptive families. By law the children are required to return to their home country. After the children return to the orphanage, families may apply to adopt them. In the near future, AAI is expecting to expand this outreach to include Ukraine, Nepal, and Ethiopia, in addition to Russia. If you would like an application, please check this box.
